

RESERVATIONS

A completed reservation form and a \$500 non-refundable deposit is due no later than March 1, 2018. An additional \$1,000 payment will be due on June 1, 2018. Reservations can be sent to: PO Box 268, Morgantown, PA 19543.

FINAL PAYMENT

Final payment will be due on August 1, 2018. Payment for retail tours can be made by check, Visa, Discover, or Master Card. Payments not received on time will result in reservation cancellation without refund. **Additional bookings after the final payment deadline may result in additional administrative fees. Fee amounts imposed are at the discretion of Pilgrim Tours & Travel.*

TOUR MEMBERSHIP & MOBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Tour membership is available to all travelers and will not be withheld if the tour operator can furnish the requirements that an individual may need. Because most of our Retail Tour sightseeing schedules require Tour Members to walk 1-2 miles at a time using a moderate pace. We cannot accept persons who are not able to navigate uneven terrain or need assistance. Should meeting these requirements materially add to the tour operator's cost, the Tour Member will be expected to pay these additional costs. The Tour Director retains the right to require non-mobile persons to stay behind when deemed necessary, and also terminate the membership of

any member displaying disruptive behavior, delaying or endangering fellow members and/or interfering with the operations of the tour. Private group tours vary in regards to mobility standards.

PRICING

Quoted tour prices include planning, handling and operational charges and are based on the current rate of exchange and tariffs. In the event of a marked change in foreign exchange rates, fuel costs or tariff rates, tour costs are subject to revision. Such increases will be added to the client's final billing. The price for this tour was based on the Australian Dollar exchanged at .77 to 1.00 US Dollar. HIGHLIGHTS OF AUSTRALIA

13 Day Adventure | October 14-26, 2018

Itinerary subject to change while touring for the best interest of the group.

Day 1 & 2: Travel to Melbourne Australia

Today we depart JFK and fly overnight to Melbourne, Australia. Sit back, get some rest and enjoy the in-flight service.

Day 3: Melbourne

We arrive in Melbourne today and are met by our tour guide who will welcome us to Australia. Melbourne's exciting mix of style, sport, culture and dining makes the Victoria capital the world's most liveable city. Our guide will offer an orientation tour as we make our way to our hotel. We'll check into our hotel where we'll enjoy our dinner and overnight.

Day 4: Melbourne

After breakfast at our hotel we'll travel to Phillip Island where we'll enjoy a visit to the

Koala Conservation Center. Here we'll explore the tree top boardwalks and see Koala's close up in their natural habitat. We'll enjoy an orientation tour of Phillip Island, also known as Cowes, before visiting the Penguin Parade Visitor's Center. We return to Melbourne where we'll enjoy our dinner and overnight.

Day 5: Ayers Rock

This morning we fly to Ayers Rock. We'll enjoy a scenic bus ride as we travel through different landscapes to Uluru-Kata Tjuta National Park. Uluru is known as Ayers Rock and Kata Tjuta is known as Mt. Olga. We'll visit Mutitjulu Waterhole, a semi-permanent watercourse nestled in the contours of Uluru and then enjoy a stop at Talinguru Nyakunytyaku which offers an excellent view of Ayers Rock with Kata Tjuta in the background. We'll check into our hotel this afternoon and enjoy the remainder of our day at leisure.

Day 6: Ayers Rock

This morning we rise early so we can see the sunrise view of Ayers Rock. Next we travel to the Aboriginal Cultural Center where we'll enjoy breakfast at the Initi Café. After breakfast we'll enjoy a guided tour of the natural history of the region at the base of Uluru. You will be able to explore some of the caves, which comb the base of the Rock and view Aboriginal paintings and carvings, some thousands of years old, which cover the walls of these caves. This afternoon we'll return to our hotel and enjoy some leisure time before we take part in a Sound of Silence Outback Dinner experience including Northern Territorial dishes including barramundi, kangaroo, emu, crocodile, bush salads and Aussie deserts.

Day 7: Cairns

This morning we fly to Cairns which is the capital of tropical North Queensland and where the rainforest meets the spectacular Great Barrier Reef. In Cairns we'll visit Hartley's Crocodile Adventures where we'll

enjoy entertaining wildlife presentations and a boat cruise to view the crocodiles in their natural habitat. Late in the day we'll check into our hotel where we'll enjoy our dinner and overnight.

Day 8: Cairns

Our morning begins with a scenic drive from Mossman to Cape Tribulation through some of the oldest rainforest in the world. We'll enjoy a Daintree River cruise where we can view the unique plants and wildlife. We'll continue our drive stopping at Alexander Lookout and enjoy a spectacular view of Daintree River estuary, Snapper Island and the Coral Sea. A tropical lunch is included on Cape Tribulation beach before enjoying a visit to Emmagen Creek with free time to swim with fish and turtles in the creek or look for butterflies and exotic birds in the trees. Late this afternoon we return to our hotel for our dinner and overnight.

Day 9: Great Barrier Reef

Today we enjoy sailing to Pinnacle Reef and exploring the Great Barrier Reef which is one of the best underwater ecosystems in the world. Our day will consist of visits to Upolu Cay and Outer Edge Upolu Reef where you can snorkel the amazing Wonder Wall or for those that would rather remain on

the boat you can enjoy a glass bottom boat experience. Lunch and a drink as well as snorkel equipment will be provided. We return to Cairns for our dinner and overnight.

Day 10: Sydney

This morning we fly to Sydney. Sydney is the capital of New South Wales and is Australia's oldest and largest city. Sydney sits astride Port Jackson, one of the most beautiful deep water harbours in the world. This afternoon we'll check into our hotel and enjoy some leisure time. This evening we'll enjoy a Sydney Harbour dinner cruise with live music, dancing and star gazing with views of the Harbour Bridge and the Opera House as the lights of Sydney twinkle in the background.

Day 11: Sydney

This morning enjoy a tour of Sydney exploring the historic Rocks area, Sydney's birthplace and travel past old pubs, restored terrace houses and quaint shops. We'll visit Sydney's commercial and shopping areas as well as Chinatown and Darling Harbour before heading to the historical Mrs. Macquarie's Chair, where you can photograph the Opera House and Harbour Bridge together. Next we visit the world famous Bondi Beach before we come to the Sydney

Opera House and enjoy a guided visit. Our afternoon will be free to explore Sydney on our own. This evening we'll enjoy dinner at a local restaurant.

Day 12: Blue Mountains

After breakfast we depart Sydney for a Blue Mountains Tour including a visit to the Featherdale Wildlife Park where you can feed kangaroos, emus and view many other species of Australian animal and birdlife. After lunch we'll explore the Scenic World Blue Mountains by taking various railways, cable ways and skyways which gives you a ground view and bird's-eye-view of the ancient rainforest.
